
Though this pandemic season is like a nightmare, we can still choose to wake up everyday expecting for the best by God's grace.

With the new set-up we are in where new guidelines are being written for implementation, we need to be flexible and be open to changes. This is very evident with government agencies and villages rules. In Biñan Assessor's Office, instead of visiting the property prior to issuance of Certificate of No Improvement, they are now requiring sellers to prepare and submit a notarized Affidavit of No Improvement instead. In RD Calamba, you are advised to call first for appointment before requesting for any documents or submitting one for title transfer. In some villages, guests are required to present health clearances from an LGU or doctor before allowing trippings; while some condominiums limit number of guests per viewing. These and more are some of the changes we must learn to live with as sellers. It may be annoying but to move forward, we need to adapt. As proverb would say, "Better bend than break."
