

## Halika... Usap Tayo... A conversation with Dr. Honey Carandang

Last April 9, PAREB held it's 4th MBC and invited Dr. Honey Carandang to talk about depression and other mental health issues at this time of the pandemic.

Unlike other bodily aches or physical illnesses, mental health problems are not easily seen. The person suffering usually doesn't want to say anything as there is a stigma that comes with mental illness.

Pre-pandemic, there was very little urgency to talk about mental health. We were all busy with our activities. But the pandemic not only kept us from going out and enjoying the company of other people; it kept us from external distractions. Without that liberty to go out and be engrossed in other things, we are forced to confront what's happening within our enclosed spaces. It didn't help that the pandemic continues to drag after 2 years. "Prolonged pandemic has caused prolonged anxiety because of the uncertainty of the situation", Dr. Honey explained. She added that too much anxiety can keep people from functioning.

#### MENTAL HEALTH

Defined by The World Health Organization

A state of complete physical, mental and social well-being not merely the absence of infirmity.

From the definition of Mental Health above, Dr. Honey noted that we should also insert EMOTIONAL well being as the emotional aspect of a person is probably the core of mental health.

Another definition from WHO is stated below.

#### MENTAL HEALTH

Defined by The World Health Organization

A state of well-being in which every individual realizes his or her own potential, can cope with the normal stresses of life, can work productively and fruitfully, and is able to make a contribution to her or his community.

Compared to other countries, the Philippines has not given much attention and national significance to mental health. "Mental health still carries a stigma which results to shame and embarrassment." That is why mental health awareness is very important.



Dr. Honey also shared three common mental concerns and mentioned that the practice of MINDFULNESS or the importance of handling our emotions.



- Anxiety
- Depression
- Posttraumatic Stress Disorder (PTSD)

Mindfulness is the art of observing your physical, emotional, mental experience with deliberate open and curious attention.

Mindfulness is awareness, cultivated by paying attention in a sustained way on purpose, in the present moment and nonjudgmentally.

Mindfulness is deliberately paying attention, being fully-aware of what is going on both inside yourself-in your body, heart and mind, and outside yourself; in your environment without judgement and criticism.

Warmed by kindness, spiced by curiosity

#### Mindfulness teaches us to

RESPOND and not to REACT.

REACT = Emotion, Action RESPOND = Emotion, PAUSE, Action

Dr. Carandang discussed the difference between RESPOND and REACT noting that the action after the PAUSE when we respond will be a better quality action as it has gone through a thought process and not merely impulse driven.



Social Media and Mental Health.

It is also notable how social media can play an interesting role in mental health. Fake news and bashing in social media is shown to relate to depression and suicidal attempts. Young people especially, tend to question their worth after being bashed in social media.

Dr. Honey also mentioned that when people post things that they want other people to see while hiding parts they tend to keep to themselves, tend to deny the part of themselves they do not deem "beautiful" or perfect or picture worthy.

Finally, Dr. Honey shared tips on how to look after your mental health which we all can benefit from....

#### How to look after your mental health

- Listen to your BODY
- · Take small BREAKS regularly
- Digital Detox
- · Create a Breathing Room
- · Going to the ARTs
- Post reminders or slogans
- · Have a list of professionals to consult or refer







### Don't Just Wing It

My dad worked as a full-time professional real estate broker in the 1990's until about the middle of 2000's. If he were still active today, I'm pretty sure this article would be of help to him, somehow. So as I write this piece, I think of him and possibly others like him who basically know how to send and receive messages via email, viber and messenger; but have no organized plan, as to marketing properties online and finding clients beyond their KKKs, over the internet.

Digital marketing starts offline and so I start this month's action steps to success, pretty much offline, as well. Successful digital marketing isn't just about getting listings out in cyberspace. It is much more about getting listings out, with the intention to sell. That starts with a good plan. Being organized is key and in this article, I'd like to share my thoughts on the first three necessary steps to a successful digital marketing plan.

1. Make sure you have Google Drive downloaded in your system. We may be starting offline, but you need to always be ready to share your files online. For easy access of your files from any computer or smartphone, anywhere in the world (for free!), you have to set up a Google account (get your own gmail address if you don't have one yet) and learn how to access Google Drive.

## THE THREE MOST BASIC STEPS TO COMPLETE BEFORE GETTING INTO DIGITAL MARKETING (Con't)

2. Make a file folder for every property you'll be marketing, and make sure that your files are available, both online and offline. Let's go on your laptop (because it's way easier to work on a big screen rather than a phone display). Open a new file folder in your Google Drive for each property and get all your properties' details ready in docs, jpg/png, sheets, pdf files, etc: Specific information, photos, available copies of legal documents and client information, at the least, should all be in each particular folder. You'll find it easier to market properties when you can find all necessary information in one place, ready for dissemination.

It would be wise to have files backed up; and be in both your hard drive (personal computer) and in the cloud (Google Drive). Syncing and copying files to both places is just a matter of dragging and dropping files to and from each location.

3. Plan your moves. List down different social media platforms you will be marketing on. Establish a schedule; when you'll be posting which listings and how often in a day. This will help keep confusions at bay.

Celebrate! You're now ready to start your digital marketing journey with confidence! These three steps may seem to not mean much, but these steps make up the roots of any digital marketing process. The 3rd PLAREB MLS Session started with Arthaland Broker Manager Mr. Oliver Raymundo giving us their project update.

Arthaland is the foremost green developer in the Philippines and the only one in the country with 100% certified sustainable portfolio.

#### MLS COMMITTEE

After the Arthaland project updates, President Joy Zepeda Abad introduced us to our featured broker for the month - Arnold Abarquez.

Arnold started by giving everyone a problem.

Mr and Mrs Pedro are both in their 80s. Mrs Pedro suspects Mr. Pedro of having an illegitimate child so to protect her two children, Mrs. Pedro hires you to transfer the title to her two children by way of donation.

They have 2 properties.

- 1. A residential house. The zonal value for land and building is P5 million
- 2. A commercial building. The zonal value for land and building is P10 million.

Mrs. Pedro is asking you, how much would be my BIR taxes?

From this problem, everyone got to work computing and evaluating and coming up with the answer, wanting to learn and also wanting to win the cash prize promised by Arnold to the one who will be able to give the correct answer.

This was an actual case Arnold worked on and from this scenario, we learned, and were reminded of the following:

- ~ Donor's tax is 6%
- ~ Doc stamps is 1.5%
- ~ There is a P250K discount per donor (owner) per annum deduction.
- ~ The above realization gives us a tip that donations can be scheduled yearly to maximize the annual deduction. (aha moment)
- ~ another learning is that owner = 1 if the title states "MARRIED TO " and owner = 2 if title states "SPOUSE" (another aha moment)



Other learnings and tips are as follows:

- ~ There is an additional P100 certification fee and P30 doc stamps per title.
- ~ 12% VAT on commercial property is due on or before every 20th of the month, DST every 5th of the month, and donor's tax due 30 days notarization of deed of absolute sale
- ~ always notarize on the 1st week of the month.
- ~ notary is needed for the transfer of title, and since the buyer benefits from this, they are the ones who normally pay the notarial fee.
- ~ seek advice, ask fellow brokers
- ~ always get the TIN of clients (buyer and seller)
- ~ verbal agreements need witnesses.
- ~In the ATS, always include VAT and business tax is to be on the account of the seller

At the end of the day, Arnold concluded that EJS is better to avoid VAT and client would pay a much lower tax due to standard deduction of P5M and family home deduction up to 5M.


